It is getting warmer and warmer, we can feel the breath of spring. I am grateful to hold Graduation Memorial Cup with 38th members.

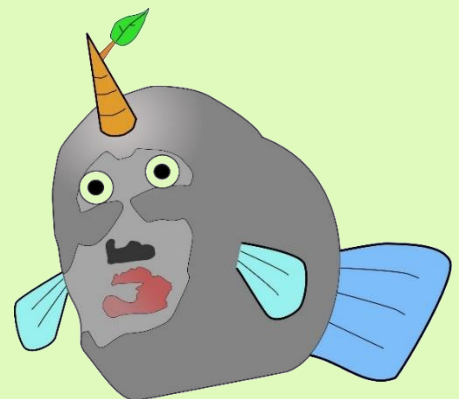
