Terrain Introduction:

Very technically framed terrain, but with good airworthiness due to prominent ridges. The land allows for a very good allergability and the areas differ quite a bit in small surfaces. The rocky areas bring a positive touch to technicality without disturbing the run. (by Mr. Marian Cotîrtă)


